The Blessing of Homes

Blessing of homes is done each year around the Feast of Theophany. This act is the central sign of God's sanctification of all things through Christ's baptism in the River Jordan and His Epiphany to the world.

When the priest arrives at the home, all who are present should gather around an icon along with a candle and a bowl of water. They should, if they are able to join in and sing of the Troparion of the Feast of Theophany. A family member then leads the priest through the house with the lit candle. As the priest walks through the house, he sprinkles holy water, and prays a blessing in each room and the activity that takes place in the room. When they have finished blessing the entire house, the family gathers again around the table and the priest blesses each person present.

General guidelines to be observed:

•A candle with an icon and holy water should be placed in a suitable location.

•, A list with the first names for whom prayers are to be offered, including members of the family and all those living in the house.

•If it is the practice to give the priest a gift, it should not be placed with the holy objects on the table. It can be prepared in advance but given at the conclusion of the service, preferably in an envelope or a card.
