**St. Nicholas** ( December 6<sup>th</sup>), Archbishop of Myra, holds a place of profound honor in the Byzantine tradition, celebrated as a model of pastoral care, compassion, and unwavering faith. Born in Patara in the 3<sup>rd</sup> century, he embraced a life of prayer and generosity from a young age. As bishop, he became known for defending the true faith during the First Council of Nicaea and for his courageous opposition to injustice.

His countless acts of charity—often carried out in secret—revealed a heart deeply united to Christ. Stories of his miracles, especially those benefiting the poor, sailors, and children, earned him the title "Wonderworker." Throughout the Byzantine world, he is invoked as a protector in times of danger, a defender of the oppressed, and a swift helper in need.

Even today, his feast remains a source of joy and hope, inviting the faithful to live with mercy, humility, and steadfast trust in God.
