### The 18<sup>th</sup> Pope of the Church

**Pope Saint Pontian**, who reigned from 230 to 235AD, was a devoted shepherd who guided the Church during a time of political unrest and persecution under Emperor Maximinus Thrax. Known for his wisdom and pastoral care, he presided over a Roman synod that confirmed the condemnation of Origen's controversial teachings, seeking to preserve the unity and orthodoxy of the Christian faith. When he and the priest St. Hippolytus were arrested and exiled to the harsh mines of Sardinia, Pontian humbly resigned his papal office, becoming the first pope in history to do so, so that the Church might continue to be led. Enduring great suffering, he died a martyr's death in exile around 235AD. His remains were later returned to Rome, where he was honored as a model of humility, faithfulness, and reconciliation within the Body of Christ.
