St. Michael Feast Day

In the Byzantine Catholic tradition, the Feast of **Saint Michael and All the Bodiless Powers** is celebrated on **November 8th**. This feast honors Saint Michael the Archangel together with all the angelic hosts who serve God and protect humanity. The angels are called "bodiless powers" because they are pure spirits, created by God before the visible world, to glorify Him and to carry out His divine will.

Saint Michael, whose name means "Who is like God?" is venerated as the leader of the heavenly armies, the defender of the Church, and the protector of the faithful against the powers of darkness. The Byzantine Liturgy for this feast is rich with hymns that praise the angels' obedience, purity, and ceaseless worship before the throne of God.

During the Divine Liturgy, the faithful are invited to reflect on the invisible world of grace that surrounds them and to renew their trust in God's protection through His holy angels. The feast also reminds believers of their own call to imitate the angels—by serving God faithfully, guarding their hearts from sin, and joining in the heavenly praise that resounds eternally before the face of the Almighty.
