Pope St. Zephyrinus – the 15th Pope

Pope St. Zephyrinus, born in Rome, served as the fifteenth successor of St. Peter, guiding the Church from 199 until his death on December 20, 217 AD. His papacy unfolded during a period of great difficulty, marked by both external persecution and internal theological conflict. Under the reigns of the emperors Septimius Severus and Caracalla, Christians endured harsh trials. Zephyrinus was tasked with strengthening and consoling the faithful in times of suffering.

Although not a scholar or theologian himself, Zephyrinus was known for his steadfast faith and pastoral concern. He relied heavily on his deacon and trusted advisor, Callixtus, who would later succeed him as Pope. Together, they worked to preserve unity in the Church, especially in the face of rising heresies. The most challenging of these was Monarchianism, a doctrine that denied the Trinity and distorted the Church's teaching on the divinity of Christ. Zephyrinus resisted these errors, safeguarding the integrity of apostolic faith even while facing opposition from intellectual critics like Hippolytus.
